**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3365**

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, after line 10, insert:

2 **“SECTION 4. (1) The State Board of Education shall award grants**
3 **to school districts to provide financial assistance for professional de-**
4 **velopment opportunities and curriculum development necessary to in-**
5 **tegrate climate change and sustainability into the academic content**
6 **standards of relevant subjects, as required under the amendments to**
7 **ORS 329.045 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2025 Act.**

8 **“(2) Grants awarded under this section may be used only for the**
9 **purposes described in subsection (1) of this section.**

10 **“(3) The board shall prescribe by rule:**

11 **“(a) The form and process by which a school district may apply for**
12 **and be awarded grants under the program;**

13 **“(b) Terms and conditions of grant agreements entered into by the**
14 **board and the grant recipients; and**

15 **“(c) Procedures for verifying that grant moneys have been used for**
16 **the purposes for which they were awarded.**

17 **“SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
18 **ation, there is appropriated to the State Board of Education, for the**
19 **biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount**
20 **of \$5,000,000, which may be expended for carrying out the amendments**
21 **to ORS 329.045 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2025 Act that require the**

1 board to include an interdisciplinary approach to sustainability and
2 climate change across all subjects for which the board establishes ac-
3 ademic content standards.

4 **“SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
5 ation, there is appropriated to the State Board of Education, for the
6 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount
7 of \$5,000,000, which may be expended to award grants under section 4
8 of this 2025 Act.”.**

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
