## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2990

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "transportation" insert a period and delete the rest of the line.
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 20 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) The Office of Language Translation is established within the Department of Transportation for the purpose of translating written materials provided by the department to the public into languages other than English.
- 8 "(2) The Office of Language Translation is under the supervision 9 and control of a director, who is responsible for the performance of 10 the duties, functions and powers of the office.
- 11 "(3) The office shall:

- "(a) Contract with a translation service to translate all written 12 materials provided to the public in the five most commonly spoken 13 languages in this state, other than English, by individuals with limited 14 English proficiency. The written materials include, but are not limited 15 to, written materials used for registering a vehicle, titling a vehicle, 16 licensing, obtaining identification cards or driver permits, taking the 17 driver licensing knowledge test and any driver education manuals. The 18 office shall ensure consistency in language translations within and 19 across all of the translated materials; 20
  - "(b) Partner with community-based organizations and experts in

- language translation as needed to meet the objectives of the office; and
- "(c) Adopt rules as necessary to carry out this section.
- "SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 336.790 to 336.820.
- "SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish a program for awarding grants to providers of traffic safety education courses to fund traffic safety education courses in languages other

- 9 "(2) A provider that offers traffic safety education courses in 10 Spanish may apply for a grant under this section.

- "SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriated ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_, which may be expended for awarding grants under
- "SECTION 5. No later than December 15, 2027, the Department of Transportation shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to the interim Joint Committee on Transportation that describes the following:
- 24 "(1) The progress made in carrying out section 1 of this 2025 Act 25 and objectives of the Office of Language Translation;
- "(2) The efforts to engage community-based organizations in the work of the office;
- "(3) The percentage of individuals who passed the written driver examination test to obtain a Class C driver license, disaggregated by language beginning with tests taken on or after January 1, 2022 and

1 ending November 1, 2027; and

"(4) The number of grants awarded for the purpose of providing traffic safety education courses in languages other than English pursuant to section 3 of this 2025 Act.

"SECTION 6. Section 5 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 1, 2028.".
