**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 914**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and
2 delete page 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 461.220 is amended to read:

4 “461.220. (1) Upon recommendation of the Director of the Oregon State
5 Lottery, the Oregon State Lottery Commission shall adopt rules that specify
6 the number and value of prizes for winning tickets or shares in each lottery
7 game including, without limitation, cash prizes, merchandise prizes, prizes
8 consisting of deferred payments or annuities and prizes of tickets or shares
9 in the same lottery game or other lottery games conducted by the Oregon
10 State Lottery.

11 “(2) In each lottery game utilizing tickets, the following information shall
12 be printed on each ticket:

13 “(a) A close approximation of the odds of winning some prize or some
14 cash prize, as appropriate for the lottery game.

15 “(b) An approximation of a payout percentage that will be returned to
16 players in the form of prizes for the lottery game. For online games, the
17 approximation may be based on the average payout percentage over several
18 prior years.

19 “(c) The statement that ‘Lottery games are based on chance, should be
20 played for entertainment only and should not be played for investment pur-
21 poses.’

1 “(3) A detailed tabulation of the estimated number of prizes of each par-
2 ticular prize denomination that are expected to be awarded in each lottery
3 game and the close approximation of the odds of winning such prizes shall
4 be available at each location at which tickets or shares in such lottery games
5 are offered for sale to the public.

6 “(4) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the commission may
7 specify by rule the number and value of prizes for lottery games that use
8 video devices or that use tickets or shares that allow a player to manually
9 reveal covered play symbols, or the commission may make such information
10 available at each location that offers such games using video devices, tickets
11 or shares for sale to the public.

12 “(5) All television, radio and newspaper advertising of a lottery game
13 shall include a disclaimer representing a close approximation of the odds of
14 winning some prize and an approximation of the amount that will be re-
15 turned to the players in the form of prizes for the game in the following
16 words: ‘The odds of winning some prize are one in (some number). The prize
17 payout percentage is (some number).’ where the numbers stated represent a
18 close approximation of the odds of winning some prize and the prize payout
19 percentage. However, this subsection does not apply to advertising the pur-
20 pose of which is to advertise the location where tickets may be purchased
21 or to provide information about the winners.

22 “(6) All television, radio and newspaper advertising of lottery games
23 funded by the lottery commission, including advertising that is intended to
24 indicate where tickets may be purchased or to provide information about
25 prize winners, shall include:

26 “(a) The disclaimer that ‘Lottery games are based on chance, should be
27 played for entertainment only and should not be played for investment
28 purposes[.]’; and

29 “(b) **The following statement or a substantially similar statement:**
30 **‘Need help with problem gambling? Call or text’ followed by the phone**

1 **number of a problem gambling helpline.**

2 “(7) All television, radio and newspaper advertising intended to publicize
3 projects or programs funded by lottery dollars shall include the disclaimer
4 that ‘Lottery games are based on chance and should be played for enter-
5 tainment only[.]’ **and the statement described in subsection (6)(b) of this**
6 **section.** However, this subsection does not apply to any such advertising
7 that has the sole purpose of educating the public about gambling addiction
8 or available treatments.

9 “(8) All billboard advertising intended to promote a lottery game, to in-
10 dicate where tickets may be purchased or to provide information about prize
11 winners shall include the disclaimer that ‘Lottery games should not be
12 played for investment purposes[.]’ **and the statement described in sub-**
13 **section (6)(b) of this section.**

14 “(9) All billboard advertising intended to publicize projects or programs
15 funded by lottery dollars shall include the disclaimer that ‘Lottery games
16 should be played for entertainment only[.]’ **and the statement described**
17 **in subsection (6)(b) of this section.**

18 “(10) A disclaimer **or statement** required by this section to be included
19 in a written advertisement shall be of a size and in a form that allows an
20 individual to readily notice and read the statement. A disclaimer **or state-**
21 **ment** required by this section to be included in a television or radio adver-
22 tisement shall be spoken aloud and, in the case of television, must also be
23 displayed visually in a form that allows an individual to readily notice and
24 read the statement.

25 **“SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 461.220 by section 1 of this**
26 **2025 Act apply to advertising that is first published on or after the ef-**
27 **fective date of this 2025 Act.”.**
