**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2385**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 21, insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘covered entity’ and ‘340B**  
3 **drug’ have the meanings given those terms in section 1 of this 2025**  
4 **Act.**

5 **“(2) On or before March 1 of each year, all covered entities in this**  
6 **state shall report to the Department of Consumer and Business Ser-**  
7 **vices, in the form and manner prescribed by the department, the fol-**  
8 **lowing information:**

9 **“(a) For each form of reimbursement, including but not limited to**  
10 **insurance, self-pay, Medicare and the state-managed medical assist-**  
11 **ance program:**

12 **“(A) Aggregated acquisition costs for all 340B drugs;**

13 **“(B) Aggregated payments received;**

14 **“(C) The total number of prescriptions and the percentage of the**  
15 **covered entity’s prescriptions that were 340B drugs; and**

16 **“(D) The percentage of individuals utilizing a sliding fee scale for**  
17 **the purchase of 340B drugs.**

18 **“(b) The total operating costs for the covered entity and an itemized**  
19 **list of costs for:**

20 **“(A) Implementing the transfer of 340B drug profits to individuals**  
21 **in the form of lower cost-sharing for 340B drugs;**

1       “(B) Implementing a sliding fee scale for the purchase of 340B  
2       drugs; and

3       “(C) 340B drugs provided with no payment or reimbursement re-  
4       ceived by the covered entity.

5       “(c) The total payments made to:

6       “(A) Pharmacies that have contracted with the covered entity for  
7       340B drug program related services and other functions;

8       “(B) Third-party administrators for managing any components of  
9       the covered entity’s 340B drug program; and

10       “(C) Any other third party for costs associated with the 340B drug  
11       program, including compliance, legal, education and administrative.

12       “(d) The total number of 340B drug pharmacies that the covered  
13       entity has contracted with, including:

14       “(A) The number of out-of-state pharmacies;

15       “(B) The total number of prescriptions and the percentage of the  
16       covered entity’s prescriptions that were filled at pharmacies, and  
17       whether those pharmacies are located in this state or out-of-state;

18       “(C) The total reimbursement paid to pharmacies or an affiliated  
19       third party for any 340B drug program related service performed on  
20       behalf of the covered entity; and

21       “(D) The percentage change from the previous year in total re-  
22       imbursement paid to pharmacies or a third-party affiliate for any 340B  
23       drug program related service performed on behalf of the covered en-  
24       tity.

25       “(3) No later than June 1 of each year, the department shall publish  
26       on the department’s website the reports filed by covered entities under  
27       this section for the preceding calendar year.

28       “SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part  
29       of the Insurance Code.”.

30       In line 22, delete “2” and insert “4”.
