**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5539**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 25 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
4 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
5 **1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
6 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
7 **cluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in sections 2**
8 **to 6 of this 2025 Act, collected or received by the Department of State**
9 **Lands, for the following purposes:**

- 10 (1) Common School Fund
11 programs..... \$ 59,265,951
12 (2) South Slough National
13 Estuarine Research
14 Reserve operations..... \$ 4,039,329
15 (3) Elliott State Research Forest... \$ 12,086,084
16 (4) Capital improvements \$ 596,145

17 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
18 **the amount of \$2,019,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
19 **1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-**
20 **partment of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup Fund es-**
21 **tablished by ORS 274.064.**

1 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
2 **the amount of \$213,600 is established for the biennium beginning July**
3 **1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-**
4 **partment of State Lands from the Submerged Lands Enhancement**
5 **Fund established by ORS 274.388.**

6 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
7 **the amount of \$2,282,425 is established for the biennium beginning July**
8 **1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-**
9 **partment of State Lands from the Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation**
10 **Fund established by ORS 196.640.**

11 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
12 **the amount of \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
13 **1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-**
14 **partment of State Lands from the Oregon Ocean Science Fund estab-**
15 **lished by ORS 196.567.**

16 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
17 **the amount of \$11,151,895 is established for the biennium beginning**
18 **July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the**
19 **Department of State Lands from the Oregon Abandoned and Derelict**
20 **Vessel Fund established by ORS 274.371.**

21 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
22 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
23 **1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**
24 **funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for the**
25 **following purposes:**

- 26 (1) South Slough National
- 27 Estuarine Research
- 28 Reserve operations..... \$ 4,325,973
- 29 (2) Common School Fund
- 30 programs..... \$ 116,945

1 **“SECTION 8. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures**
2 **by the Department of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges**
3 **and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are**
4 **not limited.**

5 **“SECTION 9. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate**
6 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
7 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.**
