PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2990

1 Delete lines 4 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **"SECTION 1. The Department of Transportation shall:**

"(1) Contract with a translation service to translate written mate-3 rials provided to the public in the five most commonly spoken lan-4 guages in this state, other than English, by individuals with limited 5 English proficiency. The written materials include, but are not limited 6 to, written materials used for registering a vehicle, titling a vehicle, 7 licensing, obtaining identification cards or driver permits, taking the 8 driver licensing knowledge test and any driver education manuals. The 9 department shall ensure consistency in language translations within 10 and across all of the translated materials; 11

"(2) Partner with community-based organizations and experts in
 language translation as needed to carry out the provisions of this
 section; and

15 **"(3)** Adopt rules as necessary to carry out this section.

"SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part
 of ORS 336.790 to 336.820.

"SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish
 a program for awarding grants to providers of driver education courses
 to fund driver education courses in languages other than English.

21 "(2) A provider that offers driver education courses in languages

1 other than English may apply for a grant under this section.

2 "(3) The department shall by rule establish the:

3 **"(a) Application process;**

4 "(b) Eligibility criteria for the grant program; and

5 "(c) Process of awarding grants under this section.

6 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-7 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for 8 the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the 9 amount of \$_____, which may be expended for awarding grants under 10 section 3 of this 2025 Act.

"SECTION 5. No later than December 15, 2027, the Department of
 Transportation shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS
 192.245 to the interim Joint Committee on Transportation that de scribes the following:
