"Sec. 3. Notwithstanding any provision of the state building code, as defined in ORS 455.010, a single-family detached dwelling that is used to operate a residential training home, as defined in ORS 443.400, or an adult foster home, as defined in ORS 443.705, is not required to have installed an automatic sprinkler system if:

"(1) The dwelling has been operated as a residential training home or an
adult foster home pursuant to a license issued prior to July 1, [2026] 2028;

14 "(2) The operator is licensed to serve five or fewer individuals in the 15 dwelling; and

"(3) The operator and the dwelling meet all other fire, life and safety re quirements established by the Department of Human Services or the Oregon
 Health Authority by rule.

"SECTION 2. Section 9, chapter 91, Oregon Laws 2022, as amended by
 section 9, chapter 92, Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:
