**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1121**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, after “161.005” delete the
2 rest of the line and insert a period.

3 Delete lines 5 through 25 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the crime of unlawful disclosure**
5 **of private information if:**

6 **“(a) The person, with the intent to stalk or injure another person,**
7 **or to cause damage to another person’s property, knowingly causes the**
8 **other person’s personal information to be disclosed;**

9 **“(b) The person knows or reasonably should have known that the**
10 **other person did not consent to the disclosure; and**

11 **“(c) The other person is stalked or injured, or the other person’s**
12 **property is damaged, as a result of the disclosure.**

13 **“(2) Unlawful disclosure of private information is a Class B**
14 **misdemeanor.**

15 **“(3) As used in this section:**

16 **“(a) ‘Disclose’ includes, but is not limited to, transfer, publish,**
17 **distribute, exhibit, advertise and offer.**

18 **“(b) ‘Injure’ means to subject another to bodily injury or death.**

19 **“(c) ‘Personal information’ means:**

20 **“(A) A person’s home address, personal electronic mail address,**
21 **personal phone number or Social Security number;**

1 **“(B) Contact information for a person’s employer;**

2 **“(C) Contact information for a family member of a person;**

3 **“(D) Photographs of a person’s child; or**

4 **“(E) Identification of the school that a person’s child attends.**

5 **“(d) ‘Stalk’ means conduct constituting the crime of stalking under**
6 **ORS 163.732 or conduct that would give rise to an action for issuance**
7 **or violation of a stalking protective order under ORS 30.866.**

8 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 161.005 is amended to read:
