**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 5524**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page  
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
4 the amount of \$3,555,245 is established for the biennium beginning July  
5 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
6 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
7 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
8 State Mortuary and Cemetery Board.**

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
10 the amount of \$1,176,829 is established for the biennium beginning July  
11 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
12 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
13 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
14 Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine.**

15 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
16 the amount of \$797,539 is established for the biennium beginning July  
17 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
18 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
19 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
20 Occupational Therapy Licensing Board.**

21 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**

1 the amount of \$1,828,620 is established for the biennium beginning July  
2 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
3 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
4 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
5 Board of Medical Imaging.

6 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
7 the amount of \$1,332,798 is established for the biennium beginning July  
8 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
9 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
10 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
11 State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and  
12 Audiology.

13 **“SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
14 the amount of \$1,940,027 is established for the biennium beginning July  
15 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
16 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
17 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
18 Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board.

19 **“SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
20 the limitation on expenditures established by section 6, chapter 62,  
21 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-  
22 imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-  
23 nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds  
24 and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon State Veterinary  
25 Medical Examining Board, is increased by \$31,500, for legal expenses.

26 **“SECTION 8.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate  
27 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
28 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
