## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2548

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 20 and delete pages 2 2 through 7 and insert:

SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall distribute the moneys appropriated to it under section 2 of this 2025 Act to the Center for Public Service at Portland State University to be used by the center to conduct a study examining the labor standards and working experiences of farmworkers in this state and evaluating the adequacy and availability of existing workplace protections for farmworkers.

"(2) The study must include, but need not be limited to, an analysis
 of the following:

"(a) Health and safety risks, including work-related injuries and
 fatalities, experienced by farmworkers.

"(b) Wages, including hourly and piece-rate compensation and work
 schedules.

"(c) Availability of, and access to, benefits such as health insur ance, retirement benefits and paid leave.

"(e) Opportunities for farmworkers to raise workplace concerns or
 complaints.

21 "(f) Gender-specific experiences and dynamics within the agricul-

2 "(g) Availability of training and educational opportunities.

"(h) Barriers to enforcement of labor protections and access to legal
remedies.

5 "(i) Employment conditions for farmworkers employed by farm la6 bor contractors licensed under ORS 658.705 to 658.850.

"(j) Working experiences of farmworkers subject to a labor contract
made under a temporary employment visa program.

"(k) The impacts on wages, working conditions and employment
 opportunities for local farmworkers resulting from the use of workers
 under a temporary visa program.

"(3)(a) In conducting the study, the center shall engage with farm ers and farmworkers representing a diverse range of agricultural in dustries, farm operations and geographic regions across this state.

15 **"(b) Engagement efforts under this section shall include:** 

"(A) In-person interviews, focus groups and other methods designed
 to gather firsthand experiences and perspectives from farmworkers.

"(B) Consultation with farmers to obtain information regarding the
 benefits provided to farmworkers and the workplace policies and pro tections applicable to farmworkers.

"(4) The commission shall submit reports on the findings of the study, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to agriculture, business and labor and natural resources, as follows:

"(a) The first report must be submitted no later than May 1, 2026,
 and must provide the initial findings of the study.

27 "(b) The second report must be submitted no later than September
28 1, 2026, and must provide:

- 29 "(A) Updates to the initial findings; and
- 30 "(B) A summary of the progress of the study.

"(c) The final report must be submitted no later than December 1,
2026, and must include the final findings of the study, including any
recommendations for legislation.

"<u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating
Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_, for distribution in accordance with
section 1 of this 2025 Act.

9 "SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2,
10 2027.

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
