<u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Envi ronmental Quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
 General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

- 6 (1) Air quality..... \$ 26,566,173
- 7 (2) Water quality..... \$ 47,345,738
- 8 (3) Land quality..... \$ 2,943,780
- 9 (4) Agency management...... \$ 2,296,337
- 10 (5) **Debt service**...... \$ 6,155,503

"SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 11 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 12 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, 13 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the pro-14 ceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from 15 congestion mitigation and air quality grants, drinking water pro-16 tection, laboratory accreditation and woodstove grants and for smoke 17 monitoring laboratory services, but excluding lottery funds and federal 18 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the De-19 partment of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes: 20

21 (1) Air quality..... \$128,108,307

1 (2) Water quality..... \$ 40,413,657

2 (3) Land quality..... \$124,002,267

3 (4) Agency management...... \$ 54,370,073

"SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
the amount of \$7,038,076 is established for the biennium beginning July
1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to the
Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to
implement Article XV, section 4b, of the Oregon Constitution.

"SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the following
 expenditures by the Department of Environmental Quality are not
 limited:

"(1) Expenditures for debt service and debt service administrative
 costs related to the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund and the
 Pollution Control Fund; and

"(2) Expenditures made for loans from the Water Pollution Control
 Revolving Fund and loans from the Pollution Control Fund.

18 "SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 19 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal 21 funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2025 Act, collected 22 or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the fol-23 lowing purposes:

24 (1) Air quality..... \$135,622,777

25 (2) Water quality...... \$ 19,083,392

26 (3) Land quality..... \$ 9,828,891

"<u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".
