(1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-24priation, there is appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the 25biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount 26of \$8,735,212 for the purpose of providing conciliation and mediation 27services in circuit courts. 28

Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, $\mathbf{5}$ the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter 380, 6 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-7 imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-8 nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including reimbursements 9 from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and fed-10 eral funds not described in section 2, chapter 380, Oregon Laws 2023, 11 collected or received by the Judicial Department, for the State Court 12 Facilities and Security Account, is decreased by \$792,500, for a budget 13 realignment. 14
