Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 6 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 7 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, 8 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-9 eral funds received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and 10 federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the 11 Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the following pur-12 13 poses:

Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 21 the amount of \$53,912,517 is established for the biennium beginning 22 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the 23 Oregon Department of Administrative Services from lottery moneys 24 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development 25 Fund for debt service and related costs for bonds issued in previous 26 biennia.

"SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
the amount of \$5,744,348 is established for the biennium beginning July
1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses to support the
county fairs in this state from lottery moneys allocated from the Ad-

ministrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services that are deposited in the County
Fair Account established under ORS 565.445.

"<u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
the amount of \$1,372,803 is established for the biennium beginning July
1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon
Department of Administrative Services from American Rescue Plan
Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the
Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the Chief Financial
Office.

"SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$163,911,525 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for purposes other than those specified in section 5 of this 2025 Act.

"SECTION 7. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the following
 expenditures by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services are
 not limited:

"(1) Expenditures from the Insurance Fund for acquiring and pur chasing insurance or reinsurance, allocating and collecting premiums
 and paying claims for coverage pursuant to statutory authority.

"(2) Expenditures from the Mass Transit Assistance Account for
 payments described in ORS 291.407 to mass transit districts, transpor tation districts and service districts.

"<u>SECTION 8.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".

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
