Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 10 the amount of \$1,345,139 is established for the biennium beginning July 11 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, 12 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-13 cluding federal Older Americans Act funds received from the Depart-14 ment of Human Services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds 15not described in this section, collected or received by the Long Term 16 Care Ombudsman. 17

"SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".

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
