In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$77,160,206, for infrastructure, for grants approved in section 9, chapter 109, Oregon Laws 2024.**

**“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development**

1 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-  
2 eral Fund, the following amounts, for infrastructure, for grants ap-

12 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**  
13 **Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:**

19 **“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
20 **the amount of \$197,247,462 is established for the biennium beginning**  
21 **July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the**  
22 **Oregon Business Development Department, from American Rescue**  
23 **Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by**  
24 **the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to**  
25 **the Oregon Business Development Department, for infrastructure, for**  
26 **grants approved in section 196, chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2021.**

27 **“SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
28 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
29 **1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses by the Oregon**  
30 **Business Development Department, from the Broadband Fund estab-**

lished by ORS 285A.167, for the following purposes:

- (1) Operations..... \$ 546,916
- (2) Infrastructure..... \$108,002,343

**“SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Operations..... \$ 19,816,525
- (2) Business, innovation  
and trade..... \$ 78,857,998
- (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 21,039,054
- (4) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,541,600
- (5) Lottery bond debt service..... \$ 66,293,285

**“SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Operations..... \$ 1,461,212
- (2) Business, innovation  
and trade..... \$ 59,333,558
- (3) Infrastructure..... \$219,985,409
- (4) Arts..... \$ 2,301,442

**“SECTION 13. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Oregon Business Development Department are not limited for:**

**“(1) Loans from the following funds:**

**“(a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon**

1 Entrepreneurial Development Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit En-  
2 hancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and Small Business Expansion Loan  
3 Fund (ORS 285B.133).

4 “(b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS  
5 285B.563), Marine Navigation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon  
6 Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708), Safe Drinking Water Revolving  
7 Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213), Brownfields Redevelopment Fund (ORS  
8 285A.188) and Oregon Brownfield Properties Revitalization Fund (ORS  
9 285A.198).

10 “(2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds  
11 and general obligation bonds.

12 “SECTION 14. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate  
13 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
14 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.

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
