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<u>SECTION 6.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the following
 expenditures by the Oregon Health Authority are not limited:

8 "SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 9 the amount of \$2,907,137,415 is established for the biennium beginning 10 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the 11 Public Employees' Benefit Board from the Public Employees' Revolv-12 ing Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.

"SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
 the amount of \$2,244,863,726 is established for the biennium beginning
 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the
 Oregon Educators Benefit Board from the Oregon Educators Revolving
 Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.

18 "SECTION 9. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-19 priation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the 20 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount 21 of \$5,000,000, to be allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for 22 Oregon State Hospital operational challenges.

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this
section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December
1, 2026, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any
purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"<u>SECTION 10.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".

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
