1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 7, delete "\$90,000,000" and 2 insert "\$65,000,000".

3 Delete lines 9 through 12 and insert:

"SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 4 the amount of \$106,387 is established for the biennium beginning July 5 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, 6 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco 7 tax receipts, marijuana tax receipts, beer and wine tax receipts, pro-8 vider taxes and Medicare receipts, but excluding lottery funds and 9 federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the 10 Oregon Health Authority, for behavioral health, for the purpose of 11 carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2025 Act. 12

"SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 13 the amount of \$96,162 is established for the biennium beginning July 14 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal 15funds, excluding federal funds described in section 3 of this 2025 Act, 16 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Medicaid, for 17 the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2025 Act. 18 "SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 19 the amount of \$618,396 is established for the biennium beginning July 20 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal 21

funds, excluding federal funds described in section 3 of this 2025 Act,
collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for behavioral
health, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of
this 2025 Act.

5 "SECTION 6. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2,
6 2027.

"SECTION 7. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".
