**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 692**

1 On page 20 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 36, delete “\$\_\_\_\_\_” and  
2 insert “\$1,000,000”.

3 On page 21, after line 1, insert:

4 **“SECTION 25. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**  
5 **General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by**  
6 **section 1 (1), chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025),**  
7 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for Medicaid, is increased by**  
8 **\$1,851,146 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17**  
9 **of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by**  
10 **sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.**

11 **“SECTION 26. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
12 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter \_\_\_,**  
13 **Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-**  
14 **ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from**  
15 **federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter**  
16 **\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received**  
17 **by the Oregon Health Authority, for Medicaid, is increased by**  
18 **\$2,072,116 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17**  
19 **of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by**  
20 **sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.**

21 **“SECTION 27. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**

1 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by  
2 section 1 (6), chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025),  
3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for central services, is in-  
4 creased by \$360,099 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14  
5 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669  
6 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

7 **“SECTION 28.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
8 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter \_\_\_,  
9 Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-  
10 ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
11 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and  
12 federal funds received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and  
13 federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
14 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health  
15 Authority, for central services, is increased by \$31,510 for carrying out  
16 the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the  
17 amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025  
18 Act.

19 **“SECTION 29.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
20 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (6), chapter \_\_\_,  
21 Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-  
22 ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
23 federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter  
24 \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received  
25 by the Oregon Health Authority, for central services, is increased by  
26 \$58,517 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of  
27 this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by  
28 sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

29 **“SECTION 30.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
30 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by

1 section 1 (4), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025),  
2 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for public health, is increased  
3 by \$407,812 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17  
4 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by  
5 sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

6 **“SECTION 31.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
7 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (5), chapter \_\_,  
8 Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-  
9 ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
10 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and  
11 federal funds received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and  
12 federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
13 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health  
14 Authority, for public health, is increased by \$140,965 for carrying out  
15 the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the  
16 amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025  
17 Act.

18 **“SECTION 32.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
19 the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July  
20 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon  
21 Health Authority for carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this  
22 2025 Act, from the Community-Based Perinatal Services Access Fund  
23 established in section 2 of this 2025 Act.

24 **“SECTION 33.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
25 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by  
26 section 1 (3), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025),  
27 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for health policy and analyt-  
28 ics, is increased by \$158,308 for carrying out the provisions of sections  
29 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668  
30 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

1       **“SECTION 34.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
2       the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (3), chapter \_\_,  
3       Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-  
4       ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
5       federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter  
6       \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received  
7       by the Oregon Health Authority, for health policy and analytics, is  
8       increased by \$27,940 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10,  
9       14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and  
10      414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

11      **“SECTION 35.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
12      General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by  
13      section 1 (7), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025),  
14      for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for state assessments and  
15      enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$23,312 for carrying out the pro-  
16      visions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments  
17      to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

18      **“SECTION 36.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
19      the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (9), chapter \_\_,  
20      Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-  
21      ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
22      fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and  
23      federal funds received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and  
24      federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
25      (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health  
26      Authority, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is in-  
27      creased by \$2,393 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14  
28      and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669  
29      by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

30      **“SECTION 37.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,

1 the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter \_\_,  
2 Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-  
3 ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
4 federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter  
5 \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received  
6 by the Oregon Health Authority, for state assessments and  
7 enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$13,330 for carrying out the pro-  
8 visions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments  
9 to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

10 **“SECTION 38.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
11 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-  
12 vices by section 1 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate  
13 Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for state assess-  
14 ments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$33,627.

15 **“SECTION 39.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
16 the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter \_\_,  
17 Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), for the biennium begin-  
18 ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from  
19 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and  
20 Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recov-  
21 ery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the  
22 Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and  
23 federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
24 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected or received by the Department  
25 of Human Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs,  
26 is increased by \$1,252.

27 **“SECTION 40.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
28 the limitation on expenditures established by section 3 (2), chapter \_\_,  
29 Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), for the biennium begin-  
30 ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from

1 federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter  
2 \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected or received  
3 by the Department of Human Services, for state assessments and  
4 enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$31,034.

5 **“SECTION 41. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
6 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter \_\_\_,**  
7 **Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), for the biennium begin-**  
8 **ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from**  
9 **fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and**  
10 **Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recov-**  
11 **ery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries and the**  
12 **Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and**  
13 **federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2025**  
14 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected or received by the Department**  
15 **of Human Services, for shared services, is increased by \$94,870.”.**

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
