**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5511**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 25 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
4 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July
5 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,
6 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
7 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
8 Department of Consumer and Business Services for the following
9 purposes:**

- 18 (6) **Building Codes Division \$ 55,071,839**

19 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
20 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July
21 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**

1 funds collected or received by the Department of Consumer and Busi-
2 ness Services for the following purposes:

- 3 (1) Oregon OSHA..... \$ 10,428,558
- 4 (2) Central Services Division..... \$ 380,973
- 5 (3) Building Codes Division \$ 231,554
- 6 (4) Division of Financial
7 Regulation..... \$120,075,414

8 **“SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the Department of Consumer
9 and Business Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of
10 the General Fund, the amount of \$1,808,965 for the Universal Health
11 Plan Governance Board.**

12 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the following
13 expenditures by the Department of Consumer and Business Services
14 are not limited:**

15 **“(1) Expenditures from the Workers’ Benefit Fund;**

16 **“(2) Expenditures from the Self-Insured Employer Adjustment Re-
17 serve;**

18 **“(3) Expenditures from the Self-Insured Employer Group Adjust-
19 ment Reserve;**

20 **“(4) Expenditures from the Consumer and Business Services Fund
21 for payment of contracted collection costs, including contracted pro-
22 cessing costs for the Combined Payroll Tax Reporting System and
23 workers’ compensation paying agent reimbursements as described in
24 ORS 656.307;**

25 **“(5) Expenditures from the Funeral and Cemetery Consumer Pro-
26 tection Trust Fund; and**

27 **“(6) Special payments to Oregon Health and Science University for
28 research on occupational illness and disease.**

29 **“SECTION 5. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
30 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**

1 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.**

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
