**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5016**

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 25 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee, for the following purposes:

(1) General program..... \$ 60,218,669

(2) Debt service \$ 58,039,936

“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,081,956 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or receive by the Legislative Administration Committee.

“SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Legislative Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies Stores Account established in ORS 173.790 are not limited.

“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$50,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,

1 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
2 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
3 Legislative Administration Committee, for expenses related to the
4 Oregon Capitol History Gateway from the Oregon Capitol History
5 Gateway Fund.

6 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
7 the amount of \$1,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,
8 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys
9 or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
10 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative
11 Administration Committee, for expenses related to operations for the
12 Oregon State Capitol Foundation from the Oregon State Capitol
13 Foundation Operating Fund.

14 **“SECTION 6.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for
15 the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the
16 amount of \$25,090,531 for payment of the expenses of the following of-
17 fices:

18 **“(1)** The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of
19 the House of Representatives;

20 **“(2)** The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the
21 House of Representatives; and

22 **“(3)** The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk
23 of the House of Representatives.

24 **“SECTION 7.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly,
25 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the
26 amount of \$36,066,804 for payment of the expenses of members of the
27 Eighty-third Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

28 **“(2)** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the
29 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount
30 of \$19,075,237 for payment of the expenses of members of the Eighty-

1 fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

2 **“SECTION 8.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the
4 amount of \$2,151,556 for the Legislative Equity Office.

5 **“SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
6 the amount of \$157,741 is established for the biennium beginning July
7 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
8 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
9 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
10 Legislative Assembly.

11 **“SECTION 10.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expendi-
12 tures by the Legislative Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account
13 established in ORS 171.117, for the costs of food served in members’
14 lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or by
15 payroll deductions from members, are not limited.

16 **“SECTION 11.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel
17 Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General
18 Fund, the amount of \$22,464,145.

19 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
20 the amount of \$2,680,921 is established for the biennium beginning July
21 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
22 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
23 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
24 Legislative Counsel Committee.

25 **“SECTION 13.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expendi-
26 tures by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving
27 Account established in ORS 171.305 and from the Legislative Publica-
28 tions Account established in ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
29 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and
30 the Oregon Revised Statutes, are not limited.

1 **“SECTION 14.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal
2 Officer, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General
3 Fund, the amount of \$10,418,582.

4 **“(2)** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the
5 amount of \$5,783,501 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,
6 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys
7 or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
8 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative
9 Fiscal Officer.

10 **“SECTION 15.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Policy and
11 Research Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of
12 the General Fund, the amount of \$24,022,394.

13 **“SECTION 16.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Of-
14 ficer, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund,
15 the amount of \$4,740,226.

16 **“SECTION 17.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian
17 Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General
18 Fund, the amount of \$1,417,653.

19 **“SECTION 18.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
20 the amount of \$7,604 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,
21 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys
22 or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
23 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commis-
24 sion on Indian Services.

25 **“SECTION 19.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
26 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
27 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.
