**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 5515**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 25 and delete pages  
2 2 and 3 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Educa-**  
4 **tion, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund,**  
5 **the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- 6 (1) Operations..... \$ 143,486,686  
7 (2) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$ 17,323,780

8 **“SECTION 2. There are appropriated to the Department of Educa-**  
9 **tion, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund,**  
10 **the following amounts, which are to be distributed as grants-in-aid,**  
11 **for program costs and to purchase services, for the following purposes:**

- 12 (1) Early intervention services  
13 and early childhood special  
14 education programs ..... \$ 250,201,917  
15 (2) Other K-12 grant-in-aid  
16 programs..... \$ 136,515,914  
17 (3) Youth development  
18 programs..... \$ 18,573,513

19 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding ORS 327.856, there is appropriated to**  
20 **the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025,**  
21 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$138,927,716 for deposit into**

1 the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Fund.

2 “SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Department of Education,  
3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the  
4 amount of \$78,578,573 for debt service on general obligation bonds.

5 “SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
6 the amount of \$70,828,864 is established for the biennium beginning  
7 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-  
8 tery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic  
9 Development Fund for deposit in the School Capital Matching Fund  
10 established under ORS 286A.806 as described in section 4, Article XI-P,  
11 of the Oregon Constitution.

12 “SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
13 the amount of \$8,693,643 is established for the biennium beginning July  
14 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery  
15 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-  
16 opment Fund to the Department of Education for debt service.

17 “SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
18 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July  
19 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses, other than  
20 expenses described in sections 8 and 16 of this 2025 Act, from fees,  
21 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
22 cluding lottery funds, corporate activity tax funds and federal funds,  
23 collected or received by the Department of Education, for the follow-  
24 ing purposes:

- 25 (1) Capital bonding ..... \$ 202,415,961
- 26 (2) Operations..... \$ 59,906,260
- 27 (3) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$ 7,513,371

28 “SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
29 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July  
30 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of grants-in-aid, program

1 costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues,  
2 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, corpo-  
3 rate activity tax funds and federal funds, collected or received by the  
4 Department of Education for programs other than those specified in  
5 sections 7 and 16 of this 2025 Act, for the following purposes:

- 6 (1) Youth development  
7 programs..... \$ 6,874,100
- 8 (2) All other grants ..... \$ 244,853,746
- 9 (3) Educator Advancement  
10 Council ..... \$ 45,781,848

11 **“SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
12 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
13 **1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**  
14 **funds, other than those described in sections 10 and 16 of this 2025 Act,**  
15 **collected or received by the Department of Education, for the follow-**  
16 **ing purposes:**

- 17 (1) Operations..... \$ 82,151,893
- 18 (2) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$ 516,066

19 **“SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
20 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
21 **1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of grants-in-aid, program**  
22 **costs and purchased services from federal funds, other than those de-**  
23 **scribed in sections 9 and 16 of this 2025 Act, received by the Depart-**  
24 **ment of Education, for the following purposes:**

- 25 (1) Youth development  
26 programs..... \$ 1,362,829
- 27 (2) All other grants ..... \$ 955,358,992

28 **“SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
29 **the amount of \$1,109,828,482 is established for the biennium beginning**  
30 **July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payments of grants-in-aid,**

1 program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education  
2 from the Student Investment Account established under ORS 327.175.

3 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
4 the amount of \$122,643,007 is established for the biennium beginning  
5 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payments of grants-in-aid,  
6 program costs and purchased services by the Department of Education  
7 from the Early Learning Account established under ORS 327.269, for  
8 early intervention services and early childhood special education pro-  
9 grams.

10 **“SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
11 the amount of \$427,741,593 is established for the biennium beginning  
12 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the  
13 Department of Education for a transfer of corporate activities tax  
14 funds from the Early Learning Account established under ORS 327.269  
15 to the Department of Early Learning and Care.

16 **“SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
17 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July  
18 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payments of grants-in-aid, program  
19 costs and purchased services by the Department of Education from the  
20 Statewide Education Initiatives Account established under ORS  
21 327.250, for the following purposes:

- 22 (1) High School Graduation  
23 and College and Career  
24 Readiness Fund..... \$ 199,151,203  
25 (2) Reengagement program ..... \$ 9,059,615  
26 (3) All other grants ..... \$ 349,727,083

27 **“SECTION 15.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,  
28 the amount of \$71,773,110 is established for the biennium beginning  
29 July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the  
30 Department of Education from the Statewide Education Initiatives

1 **Account established under ORS 327.250 for operations.**

2 **“SECTION 16. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the follow-**  
3 **ing expenditures by the Department of Education are not limited:**

4 **“(1) Moneys from the School Foods Revolving Account, Education**  
5 **Training Revolving Account and Common School Fund; and**

6 **“(2) Expenditures for grants-in-aid and purchased services from**  
7 **federal funds received by the Department of Education from the**  
8 **United States Department of Agriculture.**

9 **“SECTION 17. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
10 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
11 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.**

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
