**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 739**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 19, after “death” delete the
2 rest of the line.

3 In line 20, delete “harm or serious physical injury”.

4 Delete lines 40 through 45.

5 On page 3, delete line 45.

6 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 21 and insert:

7 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part**
8 **of ORS 443.400 to 443.455.**

9 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Human Services may not grant**
10 **a residential care facility’s request for an exception to the require-**
11 **ments of ORS 443.400 to 443.455 or any other statutory licensing re-**
12 **quirements, unless expressly authorized by statute to grant an**
13 **exception or to temporarily modify a licensing requirement due to a**
14 **declaration of a state of emergency.**

15 **“(2) If the department, under authority granted by statute or es-**
16 **tablished by rule, approves a request for an exception to a licensing**
17 **requirement, other than a requirement described in subsection (1) of**
18 **this section, the department shall notify the Long Term Care Om-**
19 **budsman of the exception request and the department’s intent to ap-**
20 **prove the request no fewer than seven days before the exception takes**
21 **effect.**

1 **“NOTE:** Section 4 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were
2 not renumbered.”.

3 On page 15, after line 7 insert:

4 **“SECTION 17. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
5 **General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by**
6 **section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025),**
7 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for behavioral health, is in-**
8 **creased by \$301,014.**

9 **“SECTION 18. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
10 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (2), chapter __,**
11 **Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium begin-**
12 **ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from**
13 **federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter**
14 **__, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received**
15 **by the Oregon Health Authority, for behavioral health, is increased**
16 **by \$301,014.**

17 **“SECTION 19. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
18 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-**
19 **vices by section 1 (6), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate**
20 **Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for aging and people**
21 **with disabilities programs, is increased by \$2,606,369.**

22 **“SECTION 20. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
23 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 3 (6), chapter __,**
24 **Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), for the biennium begin-**
25 **ning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from**
26 **federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter**
27 **__, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected or received**
28 **by the Department of Human Services, for aging and people with dis-**
29 **abilities programs, is increased by \$2,447,526.”.**
