PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 106

- Delete lines 5 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) A county may not impose, by charter provision or
- 3 by ordinance, a tax on income or measured by income, the proceeds
- of which are to be used for the purpose of providing preschool or early
- 5 childhood learning services that are not in alignment, as determined
- 6 by the Department of Early Learning and Care, with the standards and
- 7 criteria required of state preschool or early learning programs.
- 8 "(2) Subsection (1) of this section:
- 9 "(a) Applies to taxes imposed in tax years beginning on or after
- 10 **January 1, 2025; and**

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- "(b) Does not apply to a county that, as of January 1, 2025, had a
- 12 population of less than 700,000.
- "SECTION 2. (1) Not later than November 1, 2025, the Governor and
- 14 the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County shall seek
- to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to establish the terms
- 16 by which provision of county-funded preschool programs to
- 17 Multnomah County residents using county income tax proceeds shall
- be phased out not later than June 30, 2027.
- 19 "(2) An agreement under this section shall address providing access
- 20 to publicly funded preschool programs for all children who:
 - "(a) Are at least three years of age as of September 1, 2025, but not

- older than five years of age as of September 1, 2027; and
- 2 "(b) Have parents or legal guardians who reside in Multnomah 3 County.
- "(3) An agreement under this section shall set forth standards and requirements for the preschool programs described in subsection (2) of this section.

"SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
