NURSE TITLE PROTECTIONS

PROBLEM

Al technology is increasingly being used in healthcare settings. This may be a helpful resource for healthcare workers but could lead to confusion and misrepresentation about who is providing care. Oregon statute only provides protections for the title of "NURSE" for individuals but **not** for technology.

SOLUTION: HB 2748

Amends state statutes to explicitly prohibit Al-powered agents or non-human entities from being referred to as "nurses." Ensure the term "nurse" is reserved exclusively for licensed individuals meeting statutory qualifications, such as earning a nursing degree or certificate from an approved program and being licensed by a health professional regulatory board.
