- (b) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall annually adjust the maximum annual taxable income amounts specified in paragraph (a) of this subsection to reflect the increase, if any, in the average Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, West Region (All Items), as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor, since July 1, 2025...."
- \*\*\*The Department of Veteran Affairs will be required to hire more personnel to keep track of financial data.
- "...SECTION 2. ORS 307.260 is amended to read:
- ...(d) Notwithstanding paragraph (b) of this subsection, an individual claiming an exemption under this section must file annually with the county assessor the individual's income tax return for the preceding tax year of the individual for purposes of ORS 307.250 (7)...."
- \*\*\*County Assessors will go broke trying to accommodate this facet of [SB 387].
