For the past fifty years, Oregon Wild has been dedicated to protecting Oregon's waters, wild lands, and wildlife. And we're honored to stand in support of HB 2978 beside the wide range of Oregonians who have shared with you their own stories and passion for wildlife connectivity.

As you know, auto collisions with wildlife are extremely costly and harmful to Oregonians \*and\* the leading cause of death for many cherished Oregon animals. Your investments in previous legislative sessions have resulted in amazing work by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife identifying the landscape-scale movement of whole animal populations and in partnership with the Department of Transportation identifying priority connectivity crossings on ODOT infrastructure.
