... (B) Encourages and supports partnerships between school districts, education service districts, public charter schools and federally recognized Indian tribes in this state and with nonprofit organizations, community-based organizations and other organizations that provide expanded learning or enrichment opportunities.

... (ii) The accessing of grant funding by federally recognized Indian tribes in this state and by nonprofit organizations, community-based organizations and other organizations that provide expanded learning or enrichment opportunities.

... SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the After-School Learning and Enrichment Grant Program established under section 2 of this 2025 Act...."
