Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3233

The Pacific Northwest's rail system is a critical component of our regional economy and intercity transportation network. By nature, these freight and passenger rail corridors cross many borders - municipal, county, state, and even national borders. Fundamentally, the effective movement of goods and people across our region requires cooperation and collaboration on the part of multiple public agencies at multiple levels of government, as well as with privately-owned host railroads.
