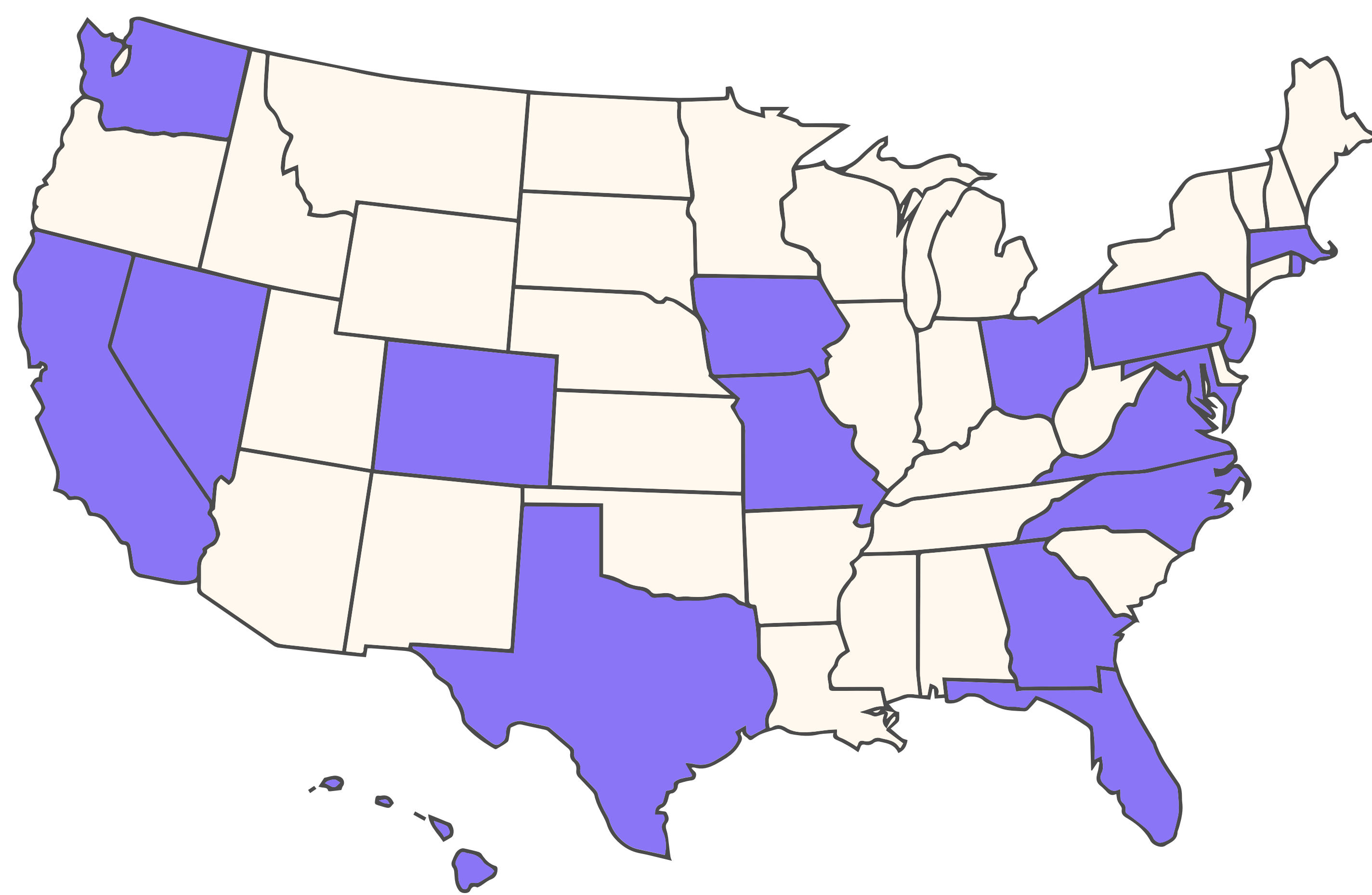

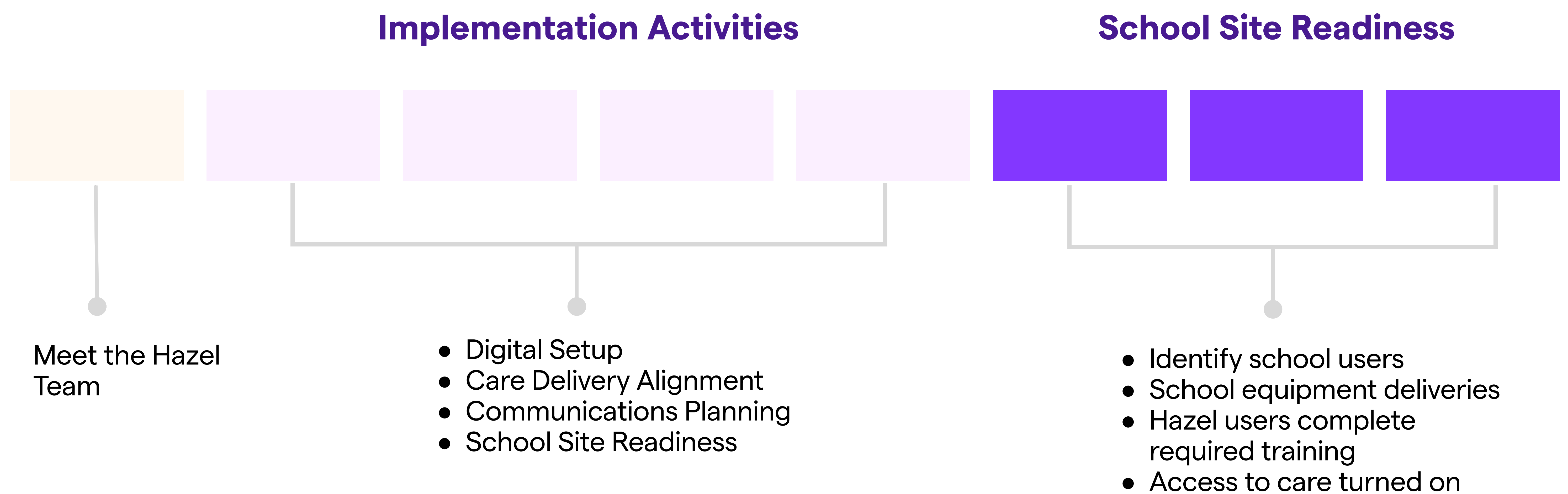

SB 701 and HB 2577: Appropriations Request

We urge the Oregon Legislature to invest \$2 million (\$1 million per year for two years) to expand mental health access for students across the state. This funding would support 66,666 kids annually. To show our commitment to serving the great state of Oregon, Hazel Health has a philanthropic partner committed and ready to provide funding for an additional 25,000 kids per year, bringing the total reach to 92,000 kids each year for two years.

This investment will provide timely, high-quality mental health support to Oregon’s students, reducing barriers to care and ensuring more children receive the help they need to thrive.
