- (1) Distilled spirits, public safety, administration and agency support..... \$153,326,514
- (2) Marijuana regulation recreational \$ 34,511,032
- (3) Marijuana regulation medical \$ 7,089.668
- (4) Agents' compensation all other......\$175,648,785
- (5) Agents' compensation distillery agents...... \$ 10,947,086
- (6) Capital improvements \$ 258,159
- (7) Debt service \$ 29,163,929..."
