Senate Bill 948, the "Play Based Learning" Bill, deserves your support. Over the past seven decades, the adults in the United States have gradually taken independent activity and play away from our children and essentially deprived our children of a childhood.

Dr. Peter Gray, a professor of psychology at Boston College, has noted that there are a number of correlational studies pointing to the reduction in opportunities to play having a negative impact on children.
