I support hunting cougars with hounds. I attempt to hunt mountain lions in our woods and the only time we can is the snow, they travel so far miles and miles. I just recently had harvested one small tom(male cougar) with straight luck because they are so hard to hunt, you have to physically see them and you still have a 1% chance of killing them. Hound hunting is the best way to preserve our wildlife and even for the mountain lions. Calling cougars with predator calls helps , but it's very inconsistent and difficult to do and it's still not enough to help with our deer and elk population. ODFW trappers already use hounds to harvest cougars so why can't we and get our deer and elk population back where it was 30 years ago. WE DONT WANT TO JUST KILL THEM. We understand the stigma behind hunting but we LOVE these animals and I'd do anything to protect them. I want to see cougars florish but they need to be controlled, it's impacting everyone's lives that hunt for a living and to put a good healthy meal on the table that's not full of poison from corporate companies that just wanna make a buck.
