Senate Bill 18 says: "Boost the punishment for certain people who committed voting law wrongs." For clarity's sake, I will refer to voting law wrongs as "election fraud" in the rest of this testimony. In Oregon, a vast election problem begins at the Oregon State Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and continues to infest the whole state election system.

I am going to pull a number of loose threads and highlight some very uncomfortable and, in my opinion, criminal aspects of our election system. First we need to address the supposedly " certified " November 2024 election.

The 2024 election had 62,949 identified illegal registrations that did not state their citizenship status. With the illegal registrations a ballot was either mailed or provided to all 62,949 illegally registered persons. How many of these people then voted in the election all 62,949 or 100, maybe 50! Since there has been no accounting of these ballots: How do you certify the 2024 election? How do you prove that a candidate either won or lost, if you cannot provide an accounting of these illegal ballots. Yet we get this statement of certification from the acting Oregon Secreatary of State.

From the Oregon Secretary of State December 11, 2024.

"As promised, both the Primary and General Election in 2024 were the most secure in history," said Secretary Griffin-Valade. "We owe this entirely to the dedicated election officials across the state, who worked tirelessly to ensure this election was safe, secure, and accurate. I am immensely proud of their efforts, as Oregon once again demonstrated why we are the gold standard in election administration."

This is why we have no trust in anyone or anybody in our election process in Oregon. It is time to fix Oregon's broken election system, clean up the dirtiest voter rolls in the country, and rebuild trust in the election system. Any public official that allows thousands of illegals to vote and then certifies a questionable election should face at the very least a public inquiry into how they can certify an election with 62,949 identified illegal ballots that nobody knows if they were used to vote or not. Plus the Voting Portal, Oregon uses has no way to check to see if the person who requested a ballot actually is a citizen of Oregon or a citizen of the United States.

The second thread we would like to pull on is Self-Attestation

Attestation: a bizarre way to run elections

In the 2024 election cycle in Oregon, we have seen a total failure of any sense of fair,

transparent, honest elections. We have a system that relies on "self-attestation" to provide election security. According to different sources, we have somewhere around 20 million illegal immigrants in this country who have crossed the border, breaking the laws of the United States. Yet, in Oregon, the Secretary of State, DMV officials, and all those involved in Oregon elections, like County clerks, expect these illegal immigrants to tell the truth about citizenship, not register to vote or vote without proving

who they are.

It now appears the self-attestation in Oregon is a total failure, as the number of illegals registering in our elections continues to rise. So far, they have identified 62,949 illegals who have registered at the DMV in Oregon's elections, and all registered people get a ballot, so the number who voted in the 2024 election is unknown.

We have some races in Oregon that were supposedly decided by less than 200 votes, so let's ask the question: With thousands of votes already identified as illegal and many more suspected, how do you certify this election without a fully transparent public bipartisan audit? There is no minimizing the damage illegal voting has done to Oregon; there is no slapping a bandage on this. Oregonians of all party affiliations should be demanding open public results. Anything less is criminal. The federal government should consider the Oregon state government an unelected body until all public audits are done.
