Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of SB 761

My name is Chad Morris, and am in consultation with Mike Odman on this letter of support. We are the City Manager and Mayor (respectively) of Milton Freewater OR.

The City of Milton Freewater has long been an agricultural epicenter of Northeast Oregon and the Walla Walla Valley. From dryland crops to irrigated row and permanent crops, our valley supports a wide range of grains, fruits and produce that is both consumed locally as well as shipped out domestically and overseas trade. Our city is home to people and businesses that support agriculture as well as many other types of entities that make a small town thrive

We are very fortunate to live in the Walla Walla River Basin and for the river water that provides many benefits. We do not take for granted this finite resource and have always been a steward of it's careful use.
