In nursing, it's crucial to have a reliable team with well-understood skills and experience. When you don't have that, it creates a hostile and unsafe work environment.

Providence is not negotiating in good faith. They refuse to engage in meaningful discussions, and the proposals they offer are far from competitive. Nurses should qualify for unemployment benefits without question, especially in a situation like this. No one should be forced to work in an unsafe environment, yet that's exactly what's happening during this strike. Many coworkers are leaving Providence due to these conditions.
