I have worked on almost every unit in the hospital and act as a relief charge nurse on a regular basis. I consistently see our units understaffed with directly effects patient care in a negative way. I believe the public needs to understand how Providence is spending their money to staff the hospitals during a strike. Nurses want to provide better patient care.
