Ending this exclusion of UI benefits for strikes that go over 7 days will help make sure that workers can pay rent, feed families, afford prescription drugs or pay COBRA health care payments while out on strike. And those UI payments will work as intended: to also put money back into the local economy at times of economic distress.
