I went from never seeing a cougar or even a cougar track to frequently seeing cougar tracks anytime I spent time in the outdoors. As the deer population tried to rebound the cougar populations exploded and after another bad winter in 2007 the deer population have steadily been declining as the cougar populations keep exploding. As my conclusion the counties need to be able to control cougar populations with dogs or the deer numbers will keep going into a downward spiral.
