From the TEXT of [HB 2510], "...SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall study the benefit packages available to school employees in this state, including health and retirement benefits. The study must analyze trends in costs of premiums, coverage and the ratio of salary to benefits as part of total compensation..."

Individual Department Administrations, such as the Department of Education's Administration should already have a database with the information requested in [HB 2510].

If the Department of Education does not have the required information, immediate and unsympathetic regime change is in order.

An increase in funding to hire more staff for the Department of Administrative Services, is required to address the mandate of [HB 2510], was conveniently omitted.
