I OPPOSE [HB 2900].

From the TEXT of [HB 2900], "...(b) If a probationary teacher is in the process of completing a probationary period of not more than one year of service at a school district after having already satisfied the threeyear probationary period in another Oregon school district, and the teacher receives notice of any performance deficiencies, the school district shall provide the teacher a 60-day program of assistance for improvement. Upon completion of the program of assistance for improvement, the school district has discretion to renew or refuse to renew the contract of the probationary teacher."

**[HB 2900] is yet another glaring example to justify the regime change of the Education Department.
