As a statewide coalition representing Oregon's local workforce development boards, OWP is committed to advancing policies that remove barriers to employment and create equitable pathways to meaningful work. SB 20 addresses a critical challenge for Oregonians with disabilities—the risk of losing essential healthcare benefits when seeking employment. This bill establishes a program that allows employed individuals with disabilities to maintain Medicaid coverage, regardless of income or resources, ensuring that access to healthcare is not a deterrent to workforce participation.

Oregon is facing a tight labor market, and the need for skilled, diverse talent has never been greater. Individuals with disabilities bring valuable perspectives, skills, and experience to the workforce, yet too often, systemic barriers prevent them from fully engaging in meaningful careers. By eliminating the fear of losing healthcare coverage, SB 20 empowers these individuals to pursue stable employment, increasing their independence and overall quality of life.

Furthermore, this legislation aligns with the Oregon Health Authority's strategic plan to eliminate health inequities by 2030 and supports broader efforts to build a more inclusive workforce. Ensuring continued access to healthcare for working individuals with disabilities will not only strengthen our communities but also support businesses in meeting their workforce needs.

Workforce development is about ensuring that every Oregonian has the opportunity to succeed—and SB 20 moves us closer to that goal. We urge you to support this bill and take a meaningful step toward a more inclusive, equitable, and responsive workforce system.
