We had to get out, it was an emergency, but there was no way i could afford to do it on my own. Our vehicle at the time was also on its last leg and I couldn't stretch my student grants far enough to get us into a better situation. I also could not get a part time job due to being pregnant with twins and also very ill from the black mold. I did not know what we would do and most shelters will not even accept pets. The maslow project got us an emergency motel room and helped us to get into a place to rent. The help I have recieved from the maslow project is the first chance I have had in years to be able to get on my feet. For years now, we have struggled, moving from rv to rv to the cruddy bus situation. I got very lucky with my rental that I found as it is zoned residental and business and is in a great location. The landlord has given me permission to open a plant nursery and florist shop while living here. I believe that this is my first real chance at building something to support my family and escape poverty so that ideally I wont always need government funding to survive. None of this would be possible without the grant I recieved from them. I believe I am a true success story because I am taking the help that the maslow project is giving me and using it as a tool to get ahead in life, so that I do not end up in a terrible situation with my children ever again. Again, I would like to express my deepest gratitude. The maslow project has changed my life and given me hope. It feels so good to be living in a real house after struggling for so long.
