My only suggestion is to try to fine-tune the program to be better at supporting the growth of a home-grown film and television industry here in Oregon (like what's evolved over the years in the television and filmmaking powerhouse to our north, Vancouver BC) - rather than mainly focusing on luring Hollywood productions. All productions are certainly more than welcome, but out-of-state projects will go wherever they get the best incentives. Whereas a strong Oregon-based industry will create quality content, contribute more to state revenues in the long run, and had the very real potential to be a powerful engine for economic growth in Oregon.
