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## House Bill 2134 Freedom to Find a Place

House Bill 2134 is a simple bill that makes a simple change that will make a big difference for tenants who are renting.

During a lease, the property owner may give a 90-day notice to the tenant to vacate the residence based on the owner returning to the residence to live in it or to sell.

The problem is, if a tenant finds an ideal place to relocate themselves and their family and it's within the 90 days, they either must give up on a chance to move to their choice or pay double the rent to secure the new property.
