Traditional Timeline

- → January/February of odd years: All Local tables and Central Table starts bargaining
- → January/February May: Bargaining continues with a greater focus on non-economics
- → May June (post May Forecast): Bargaining continues with a greater focus on economics
- → June/July: Central Table bargaining wraps up
- → Following three weeks: All Local tables wrap up
- → Following two weeks: Ratification takes place



Ratification & Contract Structure



Each local contract includes their Local Table language AND Central Table language

Each Local ratifies their contract with the new language from their Local Table and Central Table
