The health impacts of leaded gasoline on people, particularly children and the elderly, is well-documented. Furthermore, there have been extensive studies on the impact of leaded gasoline at racetracks specifically and the detriment to health in surrounding areas. As the parent of a young child living near the raceway, I am greatly concerned about how the use of leaded gas impacts their health and that of all the children in our neighborhood.
