This bill upholds tribal sovereignty and ensures ALYSSA CHATTERJEE that the nine federally recognized tribes in Oregon have authority to design, Early Learning implement and oversee early learning programs that reflect their cultures and System Director priorities within their communities. Early learning and care supports are vital for Tribal nations as they support the development and education of Tribal children and families. The provisions of this bill directly align with the Council's strategic plan, Raise Up Oregon, in honoring and recognizing Tribal sovereignty and government to government relationships. The Council was excited to learn that the Governor's Recommended Budget includes \$4.75 million for a dedicated Tribal Early Learning Fund and provides Tribes with flexible funding to access early learning resources.
