I encourage you to support HB 3191, which will provide \$9.325 million in Cultural Resources Economic Funds (CREF) for fourteen shovel-ready projects from around the state.

This slate of projects will benefit communities around Oregon, from Astoria to Baker City and from Ashland to Joseph.
