RE: CORE3 Coalition Letter

A broad coalition of local, regional, state and federal agencies have come together to collaborate to develop the Central Oregon Ready, Responsive, Resilient, "CORE3" project. CORE3 will be a dedicated emergency coordination center (ECC) as well as a multi-agency, multidisciplinary emergency services training center to meet mandatory and best-in-practice training needs of local, state, and federal public safety personnel.

CORE3 Mission

To deliver a high caliber public safety training and emergency coordination facility that enhances public safety, builds resilience, and mitigates risk.

CORE3 Vision

A model center in Central Oregon for public safety providers which delivers superior, collaborative emergency services training and coordination across disciplines, creating a safe and resilient Oregon.
