There is no evidence that the small amount of leaded fuel being used at PIR is impacting the surrounding neighborhoods, and in fact the levels of lead found at the track are below EPA limits. The evidence also indicates that the low levels of lead found at the track are likely not from leaded fuel use. Please consider the effects this ban would have on not only the loss of track rental income, but also the loss of revenue the drivers bring to Portland when attended a race weekend. Airfare, accommodations, rental car, restaurants, tires purchased from the locate dealer, racecar preparation also from locate businesses. In my experience each driver and their family will bring around four to seven thousand dollars to the area on a race weekend. PIR is a world class racing facility and a significant asset for the Portland Area. No on BH2738.
